

Can't demand admission to school citing transfer, says HC

CHENNAI: The government rules relating to admission of students to schools by transfer or migration do not give any enforceable right to parents to demand admission as a matter of right, the Madras high court has ruled.

Justice K Chandru, dismissing a writ petition filed on behalf of three minors, said even the provisions of the Right of Children for Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (RTE Act) gave only limited scope as it was applicable only to LKG or Class I and not higher classes.
